Umma Hani grew up on the chars. Even after completing her secondary education, she struggled to employment. She and her family had a very low income, and Umma Hani was a housewife. When the CLP started working in her village she received training to become a Char Shasthya Karmi (CSK), a village health worker. This has changed her and her family's life.

advice, medicine and commodities (salt, soap...). She says that community members are proud to have a doctor living near them. Sometimes families knock on her door in the middle of the night in search of urgent medical services. She says working as a CSK has benefits beyond the increased income; she enjoys providing a service to her community, meeting people and improving lives.

In addition to household visits, Umma Hani provides advice on contraception and other health issues at meetings. She also assists the paramedic in running clinics twice a month. As a CSK, it is also her responsibility to facilitate the village savings and loans (VSL) group meetings.
